What grants are currently open
for applications?

Shared Endeavour Fund

- **Applications open now! Close Friday 8th May 2026**
- Funded by MOPAC (Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime) since 2019.
- Supports initiatives that challenge racism, hate, intolerance, extremism and radicalisation in London.
- Grants £10,000 to £100,000 (three tiers of funding)
- Independently evaluated

Shared Endeavour Fund

Applications must demonstrate that the project addresses at least one of the four priority themes:

- Raise awareness
- Build resilience
- Promote positive action
- Enhance prevention efforts

Shared Endeavour Fund

- » Projects must deliver September 2026 to end of March 2027
- » Project visits required
- » Apply via our website
- » **Application deadline Friday 8th May 2026**
- » Application outcomes due in August 2026
- » Application workshop tomorrow at 12



Merton Business Energy Efficiency Support Scheme

- » Funded by London Borough of Merton
- » Provides Energy Audits to SMEs in Merton
- » Offer of grants for energy efficiency interventions
- » Businesses and properties must be in Merton
- » Interventions can vary – solar panels, insulation, lighting, heat pumps, windows, doors etc.
- » 50% match funded by businesses
- » Where businesses

Tips for developing project and applying for grants

Bid Writing Top Tips:

What are funders looking for?

1. **Funding criteria:** Does the project meet the funder's criteria?
2. **Identified need:** Will the project meet an identified need? Does this project address a gap in service provision?
3. **Track record:** Can the organisation deliver the outcomes / does it have qualified / experienced staff?
4. **Management:** Does the organisation have financial and project management systems?
5. **Network:** Does the organisation have a presence within the community / borough and established network?
6. **Budget:** Is the budget realistic, cost effective and good value for money?

Bid Writing Top Tips: 10 rules for effective bid writing

1. Clear project outline
2. Assume the funder knows nothing
3. No jargon
4. Use the funder's language
5. Read the funder's guidelines
6. Stick to the question
7. Use positive statements
8. Think of your audience
9. Draft a detailed and accurate budget
10. Read it aloud and proof read

Project / Application Development Top Tips

Project Design:

- **Resist the urge to do too much.** One focused activity trumps multiple unfocused activities.
- **Select a limited set of objectives** and then design content to achieve them.
- Consider whether project “**dosage**” and “**coverage**” are sufficient to **achieve objectives**.
- When developing tools and resources make sure to have plans for **piloting** and **disseminating** them.

Project / Application Development Top Tips

Beneficiary Selection:

- **Select beneficiaries based on project objectives.**
- Consider if “at-risk” beneficiaries **really are at-risk.**
- **Test your project** in multiple delivery sites with a diversity of beneficiaries.
- **Support beneficiaries to use the skills they’re taught** in train-the-trainer / peer-to-peer projects (NB: Funding requirement)
